COACH OF THE YEAR (2 AWARDS YOUTH BOYS & GIRLS HOUSE LEAGUE)

(2 AWARDS YOUTH BOYS & GIRLS COMPETITIVE)

- Showed an above average amount of commitment to the teams over the past 12 months as a VSC volunteer coach
- Did not miss many practices; consistently punctual
- Implement practices with the end goal of player development in mind
- Showed ability to demo proper technique; found the correct opportunities to stop and teach players
- Created a supportive, competitive environment at all practices/games
- Showed good sportsmanship (Was not abusive to officials, used appropriated language, led by example)
- Showed a good rapport with the players on the team
- Players showed substantial improvement by the end of the season
- Players had a positive, fun soccer experience
